1.What is the status of this issue? Is it possible to achieve this?

Million points:

This game is fed by random questions from the list used at Quiz Start. There's no logic to this, because the higher you climb on the reward ladder, the harder the questions become. Could you create a separate environment specifically for million points, just like you did with Word Game Questions? I could record 15 questions there and number them 1 through 15, with 1 being the easiest and 15 being the hardest. **Sorry!**

2.Quiz results: What is the status of the motivational/outcome texts in relation to your score? So, if you answer 15/30 questions correctly, you will NOT see the "TbarkAllah excellent" text.

Feedback is now determined by percentage, not points.

Percentage = (Number of Correct Answers / Total Number of Questions) × 100

Examples:

15/30 correct = 50% → "Medium" message is displayed (no longer "Excellent")

24/30 correct = 80% → "Excellent" message is displayed

18/30 correct = 60% → "Good" message displayed

10/10 correct = 100% → "Excellent" message displayed

When 15/30 correct answers are given, the "TebarekAllah excellent" message will no longer be displayed; instead, the appropriate feedback message will be shown.

New:

2. Results page:

With a good score, you'll see confetti. This will now appear on the screen for 10 seconds.

Like this:

Previous: Only points earned were displayed (e.g., "100 points")

New: Both points earned and total points are displayed (e.g., "100/300 points")

4. Results page: this is still in English

5. Results page: Please show answers to the questions earlier ("Question details").

Please follow this order:

Name > Motivational text > Points/Total points > Question details > Ranking details > Social media sharing

I rearranged the sections on the Results page in the desired order.

New order:

Name — Student name

Motivational text — Feedback message

Points/Total points — Points earned/Total points (e.g., 100/300)

Question Details — Question details and answers

Ranking Details — Statistics and ranking information

Number of correct/incorrect answers

Overall ranking

This month's ranking

This year's ranking

Social Media Sharing — Sharing buttons
